## Embedding a YouTube Video via the Add Content Button

This guide will cover how to embed a YouTube video into your Blackboard course through the Add Content area of the text editor.

Step 1: Create or Edit any item type within Blackboard that utilizes a content editor (ex: Announcements, Discussions, Content Items, etc.).

Step 2: In the content editor, select the More icon (three ellipses) to expand the full toolbar and then select the Add Content icon, which looks like a circle with a plus symbol in it.



Step 3: Select YouTube Video from the Add Content menu.

## Step 6: (Optional) You can edit how the video displays on Blackboard with the Mash Up options.

<b>Show YouTube URL</b> creates a link to the YouTube web site enabling students to browse videos. <b>Show YouTube information</b> displays length of video, name of creator and the date video was added.

Thumbnail Text Link with Player Embed Video	size when the <b>View Link</b> is clicked. <b>Embed Video</b> will show the video player directly in the page.

- **Thumbnail:** A small picture of the Mashup displays on the page with controls to launch it.
- **Text Link with Player:** A link to the Mashup is displayed on the page. Students click the link to launch the Mashup.
- **Embed Video:** The Mashup displays directly on the page when a student opens the item.
  - **Note:** When using the Embed Video option, students will not be able to make the YouTube window fullscreen.
- **Show YouTube URL**: If enabled, this option allows you to share the link to the YouTube video with the students.
- **Show YouTube Information:** If enabled, this option will display the creator of the video's name and the date the video was originally created.

## Step 7: Click Submit.
