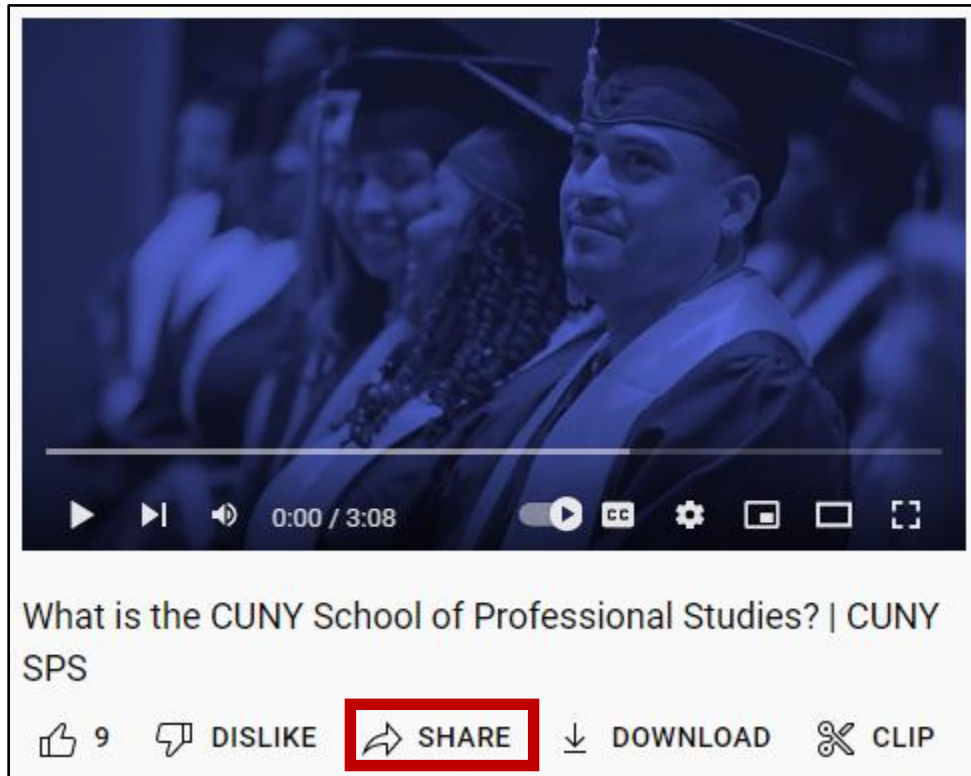


Embedding a YouTube Video with the HTML Editor

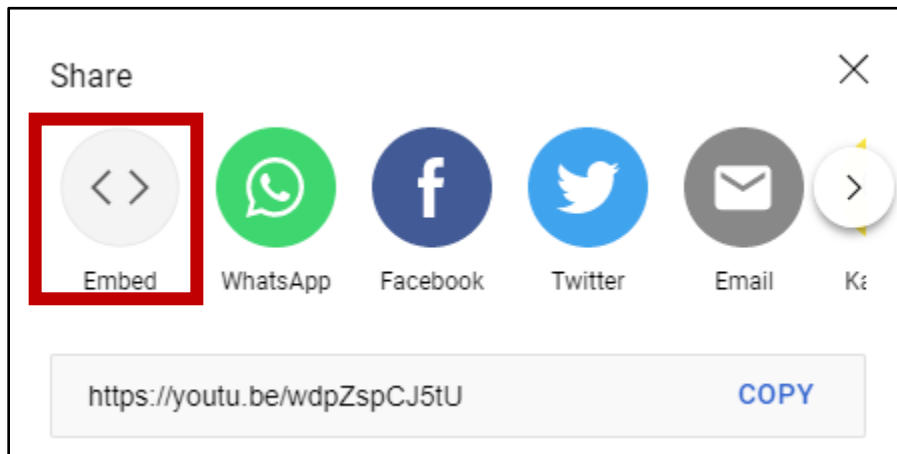
This guide will cover how to embed a YouTube video into your Blackboard course with the use of Blackboard's HTML editor.

Step 1: Go to the YouTube video.

Step 2: Select Share.

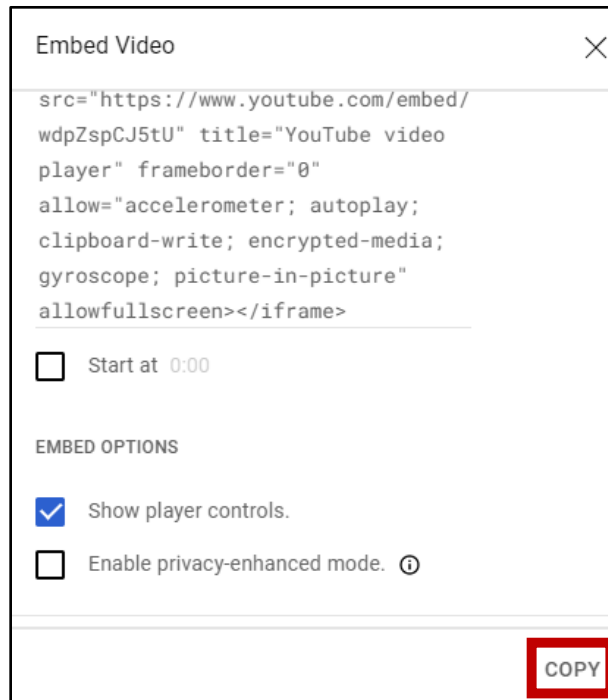


Step 3: Select Embed.



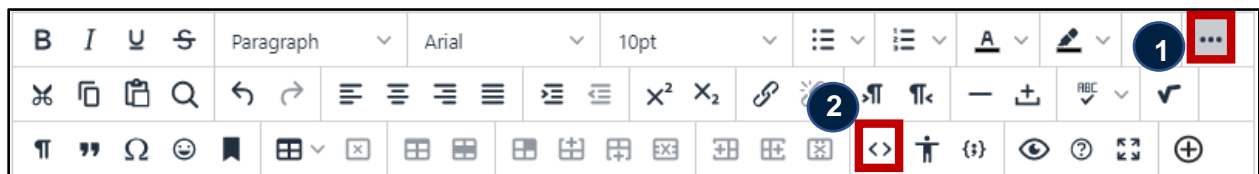
Embedding a YouTube Video with the HTML Editor

Step 4: Select Copy to copy the code.



Step 5: Create or Edit any item type within Blackboard that utilizes a content editor (ex: Announcements, Discussions, Content Items, etc.).

Step 6: In the content editor, select the More icon (three ellipses) to expand the full toolbar and then select the Source Code icon (<>).




Step 7: Paste the code in the Source Code editor followed by Save.

Step 8: Make sure to fill out any required fields and select Submit.
